DIYO FORUM (DIYO INTEGRATED RURAL IMPROVEMENT FORUM) was established in Thokarpa, Sindhupalchowk Nepal in 1993. It has been helping school children and people in need in rural areas in Sindhupalchowk and Kavrepalanchok.

We want to extend our sincere gratitude for your help with Calendar program support. With your support, we have been able to continue various programs for impoverished villagers. On behalf of DIYO FORUM, I would like to thank you.

DIYO FORUM has been doing rural development programs for villagers, especially women, students in poverty and the schools. The program started literacy class and school property supports at first. Then various programs gradually started, such as scholarships for poor girl students, school facility support, hostel support in the village and Kathmandu, calendar coloring support by handicapped villagers and vocational trainings (sewing, knitting, bamboo work, agricultural training), etc.

But a big earthquake in 2015 destroyed all the houses and schools in the area. 71 villagers died under collapsed houses. In addition, more villagers died due to the winter cold and malnutrition after the earthquake. We were able to continue some programs such as rebuilding the student hostel, distributing blankets for poor villagers in winter, and school facility supports etc. After that, during the coronavirus pandemic, support such as scholarships, school support, library book support, and calendar coloring support by disabled villagers was continued.

Once again, we would like to appreciate for your contributions to DIYO's activities in Nepal. These programs were made not only by villagers' efforts in Nepal, but also by your generous support from Japan. Your support was essential to continue these programs for years.

We hope that the bonds we have built up over the years and your support will continue.
